

## Appeal for Reconsideration

Appeal of Grade Process<sup>i</sup>

If you would like to appeal a grade awarded for a task/assignment or to query an assessment decision (e.g. authenticity, breach of assessment condition investigation), within TWO days of receiving the grade you should

- 1. In the case of a contested awarded grade approach your teacher to discuss your grade. Your teacher will explain the decision and refer you to exemplars as an indication of the grade awarded.
- 2. In the case of an Authenticity or Breach of Assessment, or once you have spoken to your class teacher and you would still like to contest your grade, you should inform Ms Kirk, Assistant Principal Curriculum.
- 3. You need to complete all the details on this form and give it to Ms Kirk, A.P. Curriculum
- 4. The form will be presented to the Head of Faculty, who will have another person mark the assessment and report back to you.
- 5. This form will be stored with your work.
