MAKE UP

• The wearing of make up at school is not allowed and students will be asked to remove it. Coloured nail polish may not be worn.

HAIR

• Hair must be neat and tidy. Hair is to be kept off the face, out of the eyes and tied back if below the collar. This is a Health and Safety requirement. Only natural hair colours are acceptable. If in doubt talk to the Head of House or Deputy Principal Pastoral (International students should talk to the International Director).

JEWELLERY

<u>Criteria:</u> Health and Safety, security, to avoid competition. Jewellery must not present a danger to the wearer or other students. It must not be outrageous or socially offensive. Many students are engaged in physical activities - whether organised sport or informally. Earrings which are accidentally hit or pulled can cause extensive damage to earlobes. Neck chains can be a danger in contact sports.

- Around neck: Cultural/religious pendants, e.g. bone or greenstone carvings, crosses or crucifixes are permitted
- **Earring:** Small plain gold or silver studs or sleepers. Small birthstone studs. Only one earring per earlobe. Studs in the nose, eyebrow, tongue or any other part of the body are not permitted. Clear invisible retainers may be worn. Band-aids and plasters are not permitted.
- **Rings:** not permitted
- Bracelets, anklets, bangles: not permitted
- Badges: Only current official Villa Maria badges and bars can be worn
